Shetland Sheep Society Wool Group

Terms of Reference

The SSSWG is a subcommittee concerned with all matters pertaining to Wool as laid out specifically in Clause 7 and bound by objects 2, 2.1, 2.2, 2.4, 2.6, 2.8 2.9 of the Shetland Sheep Society Constitution.

All members of the SSSWG including the Chairman are to be ratified by the Shetland Sheep Society Management Committee.

SSSWG members shall serve for 3 years before being eligible for re-selection for a further 2 year term. Following a one year gap, they may reapply for a further term of 3 years if desired.

The Chairman has a casting vote only as laid out in clause B3 Appendix C of the Constitution.

Remit

- **1.** To encourage members to produce wool according to our Society's Breed Description see Appendix A of the SSS Constitution.
- **2.** To encourage our members to attend and help at promotional Wool events on behalf of the SSS and provide a supportive framework to facilitate this.
- **3.** To organise educational and training events for our members and others in liaison with Area Reps.
- **4.** To promote the Breed Standard on Wool using traditional methods and modern quantitative methods e.g. micron testing, analytic data and sample recording.
- **5.** To organise an Archive of woollen goods for use by members for training and promotional purposes.
- **6.** To support the Management Committee in the liaison and work with Shetland Sheep breeders in Shetland and America with special reference to wool, and wherever else that may become appropriate.
- 7. There should be at least one face to face meeting a year.
